Caring for your cut Christmas Tree



Recut the base, by taking 2cm off the stump to enable the tree to continue to absorb water, and remain fresher for longer.



Place your tree in a Cinco stand, and tap firmly on the base with a hammer, to secure the spikes.



Evenly tighten the screws against the trunk.




Raise the tree & straighten it, then evenly tighten the screws until firmly affixed.

Place the tree inside, away from windows, direct sunlight, TV & other heat sources as they will prematurely dry the tree out. Cut away the netting.



Fill the stand with water and keep topped up. It will require watering each day to begin with. If the tree runs out of water, the base of the tree will 'seal over' & require recutting to enable the tree to absorb water.





If you can't put your tree up immediately, store it in a bucket of water, inside, away from sunlight, windows & heat sources If properly cared for, your Christmas tree will last 3 weeks.
